Childcare Worker (Looked After Children), Children Schools and Families

To look after and parent a group of young people in a children's home who may have had damaging life experiences and help them reach their potential. In some of our homes we are looking after disabled children. Key duties to include:

1. To act as a responsible parent to help young people with all aspects of their lives.
2. To help young people develop socially, educationally and emotionally within a multi-cultural society.
3. To provide support and guidance to young people and to help them make sense of their past experiences.
4. To be involved with the young people and to support their schooling, hobbies and leisure activities.
5. To help provide a safe and stable home environment for young people.
6. To work as part of a team.
7. To attend supervision sessions, an individual time with your Manager to discuss your work and reflect on your learning and development.
8. To attend staff meetings, a time for the team to discuss the young people and their care and any other issues related to the work.
9. To attend training to improve knowledge, practice and to develop new skills.
