

ADMISSIONS UPDATE 2007

1. Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 To update the Admissions Forum on the admissions to nursery, primary, junior and secondary schools.

2. Summary

2.1 Nursery Admissions

The percentage of pupils offered a ranked school on allocation day was 97.37%. The percentage of Hertfordshire ontime pupils offered a ranked school was 98.11%.

The percentage of ontime Hertfordshire pupils offered one of their ranked schools as at 7 June (post CI 3) is 98.64%.

2.2 Primary Admissions

Further to the report to the Admissions forum of 22nd February 2007 when it was reported that the percentage of Hertfordshire ontime children offered a ranked school, on allocation day, was 97.07%.

The percentage of ontime Hertfordshire pupils offered one of their ranked schools as at 04 May 2007 (post CI 6 and hand back to school) is 97.82%.

2.3 Junior Admissions

The percentage of pupils offered a ranked school on allocation day was 98.75%. The percentage of Hertfordshire ontime pupils being offered one of their ranked schools on allocation day was 99.35%.

The percentage of ontime Hertfordshire pupils offered one of their ranked schools as at 24 May 2007 (post CI 3 and hand back to schools) is 99.38%.

2.4 Secondary Admissions

The percentage of pupils offered a ranked school on allocation day was 81.78%. The percentage of Hertfordshire ontime pupils being offered one of their ranked schools on allocation day was 94.72%.

The percentage of ontime Hertfordshire pupils offered one of their ranked schools as at 25 May 2007 (post CI 5) is 95.68%.

The following table shows the number of Non-Ranked Allocations (NRAs) in parts of Hertfordshire where there has been pressure on places.

4. Process details

4.1 Nursery applications and allocations in 2007.

There were 9,743 applications for nursery school places in 2007. 162 were from outside Hertfordshire and 9581 were from Hertfordshire.

4.2 Primary applications and allocations in 2007.

There were 12,029 applications for primary school places in 2007. 297 were from outside Hertfordshire and 11,732 were from Hertfordshire.

4.3 Due to the high number of applications for school places in St Albans, we increased the Published Admissions Number (PAN) by 30 at Aboyne Lodge School, Maple School and St Peters School. The following information shows the number of places in schools in St Albans and surrounding areas.

4.4 **Junior/Middle applications and allocations in 2007.**

There were 2,727 applications for Junior/Middle school places in 2007. 58 were from outside Hertfordshire and 2,669 were from Hertfordshire.

4.5 **Secondary applications and allocations in 2007.**

There were 15,646 applications for secondary school places in 2007. 3,097 were from outside Hertfordshire and 12,549 were from Hertfordshire.
