NOTES:

- (a) "Petroleum Mixtures" means all mixtures (whether liquid, viscous or solid) of petroleum with any other substance except mixtures which, when tested in the manner set forth in the Petroleum (Mixtures) Order, 1929, do not give off an inflammable vapour at a temperature below 21 degrees Celsius. In the case of solid Mixtures of Petroleum, 1 kilogram is to be regarded as the equivalent of one litre.
- (b) All cheques and postal orders should be made payable to the "Hertfordshire County Council".

- (c) Scale of Fee payable to the Local Authority by the persons to whom a Licence is granted to keep Petroleum Spirit as fixed by the Petroleum (Consolidation) Act 1928. First Schedule as amended by the Miscellaneous Fees (Variation) Order 1968.
- (d) Capacity, if applicant signs on behalf of a company or partnership.
