**Car parking**

There will be no public parking on the County Hall campus. Anyone attending the event who wishes to travel by car is advised to park in the town centre car parks and make their way on foot to County Hall.

**Coach transport**

There will be an area set aside on the entrance road by the cricket pitch for coaches to drop off and pick up. For safety reasons only three coaches will be able to drop off or pick up at any one time. There will be coach drop off/pick up points clearly signed A, B and C.

In order to manage the flow of traffic, we have asked group organisers to notify us of the arrival time of coaches. To accommodate the groups which have been notified to us, we may refuse entry to unscheduled coaches.

We would ask that each coach has identified marshals to ensure that the pick up operation operates as smoothly and safely as possible.

**Welfare facilities**

There will be a welfare post which will include first-aid, water supply and a lost/missing person bureau. Toilets for those with tickets for the council chamber or overflow room will be within the building. A temporary toilet block will be available for those not going into the building.

**Multi-faith service**

A campaign group is organising a multi-faith service which will commence at 9.30am and will be held in the front car park to the right of the steps leading to the main entrance.

**Safety and Security**

To ensure that everyone who wishes to attend can do so in safety, HCC will provide marshals to manage on-site traffic and entrance to the building. We would ask that everyone attending cooperates with the marshals.

**County Hall public and staff access**

18<sup>th</sup> July will be a normal working day for the 1,700 staff based at County Hall and therefore access for staff and public will need to be maintained. We would ask everyone to cooperate with the marshals managing access to the building.
