

PRIMARY ALLOCATIONS 2006

1. Purpose of the Report

To inform the Admissions Forum of the allocations to primary schools within Hertfordshire.

2. Primary Allocations

- 2.1 There were 11,116 initial applications for primary school places and on allocation day, 97.51% of pupils received a ranked allocation. This satisfaction rate showed an increase of 1.11% compared with last year.
- 2.2 90.38% of pupils received their first ranked school. This satisfaction rate showed an increase of 1.42% compared with last year.
- 2.3 There was a reduction in the cohort this year of 5.6%. Last year there were 11772 initial applications for primary school places on allocation day.

3. Online Applications

- 3.1 5593 applications were made online and ontime, this being 51.67 % of the total.

4. Summary

4.1 Primary Admissions

- The percentage of pupils offered a ranked school on allocation day was 97.51%, an increase of 1.11% on 2005.
