In accordance with Regulation 28 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, Hertfordshire County Council has submitted the Waste Core Strategy to the Secretary of State for examination. It is available for inspection and subject to a 6 week period of consultation.

This document will form part of the Hertfordshire Minerals and Waste development framework. It sets out the County Council's vision, objectives and overall spatial strategy for waste development for the period 2005-2021 for the County of Hertfordshire.

Copies of the Waste Core Strategy submission document are available for public inspection at County Hall, Pegs Lanes, Hertford, free of charge on Mondays to Fridays between 9am to 5pm, and at your local District/Borough Council office – please contact their offices for opening hours.

Representations may be made to the County Council on the Waste Core Strategy and accompanying documents within the period of 6 weeks beginning on 28th January 2008. Representations must be received by the County Council before 5pm on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2008. A representation form is available online.

Representations may be accompanied by a request to be notified at a specified address of the publication of the recommendations of the inspector appointed to carry out an examination under section 20 or the adoption of the DPD, or both.
